



HIS LIGHT IN SHINING FACES – THE SHINING ONES

What happens to those who abide and receive from His abiding anointing?

Because you are walking in the light as He is that light Him emanating light and life is imparted to these. Light and life comes from Yeshua. Those who communion with Him receives the anointing from Him which He imparts! This is called the Abiding Anointing. When you are reading God's word you are actually gazing into the face of Yeshua. So Yeshua is the word made flesh. Yeshua said that His words are "*Spirit and they are Life,*" such is the exchange when we abide, shutting in with Him for this transfer of His Glory.

I remember a minister telling a story about going to the grocery store, and while in there, a woman checking out noticed *a light* against the back wall of the store. She stopped checking out to find where *this light* was coming from. The *glair of the light* grew stronger as she came to the back of the store. There she saw a man and a grocery cart placing food in his basket. She went up to him and said, "*I guess you know that there is an orah of light all around you.*" The minister answered, "*Yes, that is Yeshua within me do you know Him.*" He led the women right there on the spot to receive Yeshua as Saviour and her Lord. This is how powerful the abiding anointing came be with you also!

You can become a carrier of this same radiant presence, and take in everywhere. People will notice you because of the Spirit of God who resides in and upon you just as the Master told us.

Numbers 6:25

The LORD *make His face shine on you,* And be gracious to you;

Exodus 34:30

So when Aaron and all the sons of Israel *saw Moses, beheld, the skin of his face shone,* and they were afraid to come near him.

Ecclesiastes 8:1

Who is like the wise man and who knows the interpretation of a matter? *A man's wisdom illumines him and causes his stern face to beam.*

Matthew 17:2

And He was transfigured before them; and His face shone like the sun, and His garments became as *white as light.*

Matthew 28:3

And his appearance was like lightning, and *his clothing as white as snow.*

John 12:35

Then Jesus told them, “You are going to have *the light* just a little while longer. *Walk while you have the light*, before darkness overtakes you. Whoever walks in the dark does not know where they are going.

John 8:12

When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, “*I am the light of the world*. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but *will have the light of life*.”

Matthew 5:14

“*You are the light of the world*. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden.

Acts 6:15

And *fixing their gaze on him*, all who were sitting in the Council saw *his face like the face of an angel*.

Philippians 2:15

so that you may become *blameless and pure*, “children of God *without fault* in a warped and crooked generation.” Then you will *shine among them like stars in the sky*

2 Corinthians 4:6

For God, who said, “*Let light shine out of darkness*,” made *his light shine in our hearts to give us the light* of the knowledge of *God’s glory displayed in the face of Christ*.

2 Corinthians 3:7

But if the ministry of death, in letters engraved on stones, *came with glory*, so that the sons of Israel could not look intently at *the face* of Moses *because of the glory of his face*, fading as it was,

1 John 1:7

But if we *walk in the light, as he is in the light*, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

Proverbs 27:19

As *water reflects the face*, so one’s life reflects the heart.

2 Corinthians 3:18

And we all, who with *unveiled faces* reflect the Lord’s glory, *are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory*, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

James 1:23-25

Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is *like someone who looks at his face in a mirror* and, *after looking at himself*, goes away and immediately *forgets what he looks like*. But *whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom*, and *continues in it—not forgetting*

what they have heard, but *doing it—they will be blessed in what they do.*

Numbers 6:24-26

The LORD bless you, and keep you; *The LORD make His face shine on you,* And be gracious to you; *The LORD lift up His countenance on you,* And give you peace.'

Exodus 34:29-35

It came about when Moses was coming down from Mount Sinai (and the two tablets of the testimony were in Moses' hand as he was coming down from the mountain), that Moses *did not know that the skin of his face shone* because of his speaking with Him. So when Aaron and all the sons of Israel saw Moses, *behold, the skin of his face shone,* and they were afraid to come near him. Then Moses called to them, and Aaron and all the rulers in the congregation returned to him; and Moses spoke to them.

Psalms 104:15

And wine which makes man's heart glad, So that *he may make his face glisten with oil,* And food which sustains man's heart.

Psalms 80:3

O God, *restore us* And cause *Your face to shine upon us,* and we will be saved.

Psalms 80:7

O God of hosts, *restore us* And cause *Your face to shine upon us,* and we will be saved.

Isaiah 60:1

Arise Shine, for thy Light is come, and the Glory of YHWH your Elohim is risen upon thee!
