# BACK TO OUR FUTURE RESTORING THE MODEL EARLY CHURCH TODAY

Introduction: *This is a mandate for all our members to read through!* The teaching that you are about to familiarize yourself with has already been taught and used around the globe by sources of missionaries who have populated the church of Messiah!

However, it is unfortunate that so great a teaching has been overlooked in America. However, the neglect of this strategy of this anointed plan of God written down in the book of the Acts of the Holy Spirit will be restored and used in these last days! It all starts with the DNA of multiplication given to us through the Apostle Paul when He gave his instructions of choosing people who were faithful and would teach other. This is called Discipleship. When believers become Commissioned Disciples like Yahshua picked to change the world. If the church would carry-out this anointed commission following those instructions, the globe could be witnessed to in a mere 34 years! Note: If we look at the book of Acts we can see the results of this plain which spread everywhere. This is same template which the Holy Spirit worked through every believer is for today. This template we define and refer to, we called **THE ACTS BLUE PRINT!** 

# **Micro-Church Principle of 12 Set-Aside Ones**

At the beginning of Yahshua's ministry, Yahshua chose 12 men to be His core team that would carry out the work He assigned them to do. It was a dynamic missional relationship that would last throughout their lives. This was a deliberate God-given strategy, of which the Father, Yahshua and the Holy Spirit set up to bring the whole world to salvation!

Messiah's main goal here was to raze up "Set-Aside ones" Talmidim, "Dedicated Followers", Kedoshim, "Holy Ones" who through Haverim, "Partnership, Study, and Training" would serve in His resurgence and restoration movement! These are who we are looking for today in these Last days.

Yahshua was drawing all the spiritually hungry unto Himself through the Holy Spirit. His purpose was clear, being the "Anointed one," the Messiah,

#### **One Flock One Shepherd King**

He would *set the captives free*, and raise an "Anointed people;" a remnant of followers, who would do the same as He, reaching out to those who were looking for the promise of reconciliation with Elohim/ Yahweh; for them to receiving inner Shalom, a peace which can only be established under divine order of the Kingdom of God! Yahshua, the Father and the Spirit as the Godhead community, all had the same mind; one goal in mind, which was to establish "One flock, under One Shepherd and bring about the salvation of every nation!

#### **The Spirit And The Mission**

We can see that His 12 talmidim/ disciples occupied a position of significance as the plan of God unfolded by them following His Spirit. The Holy Spirit was the one which they followed and aligned themselves with the cause of the Gospel message, to spread it throughout the earth. God's purpose can be seen in Revelation which describes the New Jerusalem – the city of God in which a transformed humanity would take part in. This gives us a picture of the result of this plan because we see God's people perfected in heaven. John tells us that... "Now the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb." Revelation 21:14

#### **Model Of The Twelve**

The relationship model of the 12 is seen in heaven, with the 24 elders being those of the Old Covenant and those of the New. We can see the power of agreement when we all unite together. This government before the throne of God is a government which has the Lord as its centre. The model of the 12 upholds the apostolic theology which was given to the Apostles, and then passed down between groups of twelve which continued this pattern spreading out throughout the unsaved world! We here are speaking of the implementation of the vision of Yahshua, and the Model of 12 approach given by Him; THE WAY OF THE MASTER YAHSHUA which He planned to carry out, is the Great Commission and the Government of heaven; the Kingdom of God in bringing the foretaste of restoration before the consummation of His return!

# **Our Need For Mentorship**

Yahshua chose and trained them to be His successors. This was God's appointed method of reaching the multitudes and disciplining them. Yahshua choice of 12 established a principle of operation for evangelism and discipleship.

#### **The In-Gathering Harvest**

This is the in-gathering and practical way of calling and gathering the multitudes – bringing the crowds of the marketplace into the gathering fellowship of disciples. (Ecclesiola)

Yahshua had compassion on the multitudes, and it is clear and visible that this way was the practical and effective way place of action. He called His own, the 12 to heal the sick, taught them the truth of the Kingdom, fed them spiritually, the exercised that teaching in emulating Him and He called His 12 to reach the multitudes. From beginning to end He called them His own, just as He does us, calling us into His Great Commission!

#### **Review:**

Matthew 4:19 "And Yahshua said to them, "Come after me, and I shall make you to become fishers of men."

Matthew 9 "But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, 'The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest." Matthew 9:36-38

John 17:18 "Just as you have sent me into the world, I also have sent them into the world."

Notice Yahshua's motives. Matthew records these sheep have no shepherd; they are weary, and scattered. Revealed here for us is the unveiled concept, that of a scattered crowd! Yahshua wanted them to be His sheep; he wanted them to be within His Ecclessia, among His community of disciples. So they were to gather them into the fold. This issue here is that He wants them to come under His pastoral care as the good Shepherd. He tells us there is no problem with the harvest itself, but it is with the lack of workers gathering in His plentiful harvest. Then just wasn't enough! We should be focusing on the harvest, as Yahshua is focused on the harvest, the precious souls who are doomed to judgment. What is wrong with this picture? This is a clear indication of how He is calling His church.

# **Focus On The Training**

We are to train, equip and release workers into the harvest fields, and the principle of 12, is how we change everything around!

Watch how in Matthew 10:1 He gave them power...

"And when He had called His twelve talmidim/ disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease."

Immediately, Yahshua calls His 12 and Matthew records how Yeshua gave them the power to heal the sick and to cast out demons. Jesus equipped His 12 to preach the Gospel of the Kingdom.

## Yahshua Left The Multitudes To Develop His 12

This shows us what kind of workers Yahshua wants to release into the harvest fields – workers like Him. Matthew has shown us how Yahshua/ Jesus reached the lost: by teaching, preaching and healing (Matthew 9:35). This should now make sense of Him calling His 12. It was that He discipled them at close proximity, and train them for missional work.

This was to reach the multitudes, which Yahshua turns over from Him to Them; His own 12! Here we now see clearly, seeing the practical reason why Yahshua worked this way with His 12. He chose to equip others so that they could do the work of the kingdom. This implies that He also taught them how to train, and raise up others so that this process would extend and continue uninterrupted until the work would be completed!!!

# **Growing The Church Which Are The People Not The Steeple**

This clearly and unambiguously establishes the principle of discipleship as the means of spreading the gospel, the growth of the church and the expansion of the kingdom of God. That is why the cell vision is at heart a discipleship vision. Paul draws on this principle when he writes to Timothy.

# The DNA Of Multiplication!

"And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also." 2 Timothy 2:2

Here we find at least 4 generations of spiritual communication – Paul, then Timothy, followed by those whom Timothy was discipling and, finally, those whom these men would go on to disciple. That is how the multitudes are won for Messiah. Beginning with one person who follows this principle, it takes just 10 generations or cycles of discipleship before there are over 1,000 followers of Yahshua! Expanding this figure by continuing on this path it is said that in 34 years the globe who be covered and the gospel given to every person.

## Yahshua Massive Movement - Our Assignment

His multiplication began with a small group and inner circle and became a massive movement of followers. Many were called through this massive movement, but only few were the chosen ones [those who became Set-apart ones] out of that multitude. This was because all aren't ready to take up their cross and follow Him. When Yahshua spoke of taking up the cross and following Him, He means them to understand that the cross was an instrument of death, which they would need take, and die to themselves in order to truly follow Him with their whole heart! Yahshua saw right through people, and He knows who are truly Him own, and these came His fruitful disciples.

# The continuing strategy of making talmidim through discipleship

Acts shows that all the 3,000 people who were converted on the Day of Pentecost were successfully assimilated into the church. This level of consolidation is almost non-existent today.

"And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers." Acts 2:42

The secret lay in the discipleship methods of Jesus in which the small groups played a crucial role. An important factor to understand is that all the set-aside ones united around the centrality of receiving the Lord's Supper.

"So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread [celebrating communion] from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart." Acts 2:46

This daily contact was more than just the opportunity for friendship and table fellowship; it was the ideal context for discipleship development. This is how being under the Apostles' teachings they united, having the same understanding of the scriptures, and receiving the one heart of God.

So Yahshua's method of raising up teams of people, focusing on their discipleship training and releasing them to do the same is clearly established and indisputable. But what about the number 12? Why should we follow Jesus' practice of raising up 12?

# A Workable Anointed Strategy For our Times!

No New Testament injunction states every leader must grow and develop his or her own 12 in the way that Yahshua did this. Choosing 12 is not a doctrine, but a missionary strategy. Sociologists tell us that 12 is the optimum number for people to relate to each other and be involved with each other on a regular and personal basis.

The number 12 is the optimum number for a primary group to maximize the small group dynamic for effective relationships. This becomes the foundation for all else that can be achieved through a small group – friendship, nurture, training and discipling. Every person can get to know everyone else in the group at a level of depth and can have personal and intimate knowledge of each other's character and life experiences. This intimacy is necessary for the effective discipleship and mentoring that the groups of 12 seek to accomplish. Mark records that Yahshua's primary purpose in choosing the 12 was that "they might be with him" and that this would mean he could equip them and send them out to preach the gospel.

"He appointed twelve, that they might be with Him and that He might send them out to preach." Mark 3:14

This means that the number 12 is an effective building block for discipleship. A primary leader can grow his or her 12 and release them to do the same, optimizing the small group principle that propagates the Messiani-Christian faith. Therefore, we can say that a model of 12 developed for today is a practical way of implementing the example of Yahshua, a time tested

success of evangelism. In this context, it should be everyone's Godly goal, for everyone who wants to be *an effective spreader* of the *Gospel* and *discipler* to others, to develop and grow his or her group of 12. We have adopted this today at Way Of The Master Yahshua. Com which is a Micro-Church Hub. Being a Micro-Church means we are one church which meets up together in small groups for fellowship each week and overall gather together corporately! We train our people and developed them through a one years training school called SCHOOL OF ACTS! Through our School members are trained, become Commissioned Disciples, become Team Leaders, and are sent out to establish a new meeting group. We also gather weekly to do Luke 10 trips together on weekends. Check out our webpage for more details.
