"MICRO CHURCH MOVEMENT: ARE YOU LISTENING?"

THE TRANSFORMING MANDATE FOR MAKING COMMISSIONED DISCIPLES!!! VALUABLE NOTES... A PROPHETIC MANDATE from HEAVEN!

LET'S REVIEW: Let's compare the overall state of the church today. Only 5% to 9% of the modern traditional church actively disciples their members to receive training in becoming true disciples. This means the same 5% to 9% are the only ones who go out and practice the Great Commission! When we talk about discipleship it is not just about head knowledge alone, but mentorship becoming an apprentice. The kind of discipleship I am talking about includes all the robes which many don't even call discipleship. They leave out what Yahshua didn't leave out in His disciple training which was Praying in the Spirit, the Laying on of hands for healing, Casting our Devils, and the overall Hearing the head of the church which leads in the successful ministry in real time! How can people be disciples without following how Yahshua made His disciples so that they would be spiritually successful? Yes, it is very sad what they call discipleship and this has made the body of Messiah weak.

Personally I find this to be disheartening, especially when Yahshua commanded His disciples to make more disciples, just as Paul instructed his disciple Timothy. I think Yahshua weeps over His church for not lessening to make changes which are necessary.

It is shocking to discover the current state of the church in our generation! It is our responsibility to change this equation. To do this, we must review the church's current situation and make some necessary comparisons. Let's reflect on this together and work to turn things around. This is the essence of the Micro Church Movement in reaching our world through the ACTS BLUEPRINT PATH!

Each individual needs to know the following:

1. Take an Honest Look at Where You Are.

Ask the hard questions: - How are the people in my church obeying Yahshua's call in their everyday lives and bearing much fruit? - Are they growing from spiritual infants to becoming spiritual parents and leaders, stepping into ministry? - Are we making unconverted converts, just casual church-goers, or strong disciples prepared for team leadership? - Are we seeing multiplication in the third and fourth generations, or merely addition? If we are not there, are we willing to embrace change and do what is necessary?

2. New Birth and Mindset Change.

Ensure everyone is fully born again by guiding them toward deep repentance, baptism in water, and being filled with the Holy Spirit. Help them experience freedom from sin and develop a love for Jesus that compels them to share everything they have experienced. We must transition from being hearers of the Word to doers by changing our mindset from being unconverted converts or casual Christians to becoming faithful disciples who obey Yahshua's call daily and take up their cross.

3. Going from Hearing Teaching to Equipping for Action.
Help people move from hearing for themselves to learning to give to others. They should not only

repent but also become capable of leading others to repentance. They should transition from being baptized to becoming those who baptize others, and from receiving the Holy Spirit to giving the Spirit to others. As it says, "Freely you have received; freely give."

Teach and then go and do. Change the DNA of the church, and the movement will begin, leading to true multiplication and the formation of new gatherings. The call of Yahshua focuses on Luke chapter 10, where He commissioned and sent His disciples out. We need to learn how to walk led by the Spirit, find persons of peace, preach the Gospel, heal the sick, and cast out demons. We should aim to reach whole households, help them be born again, and raise them up from spiritual infancy to spiritual parenthood in Messiah. Let's identify the people of peace who are open and hungry, drawn by His Spirit. After leading them to Yahshua our Messiah, let's lay a solid foundation and see new fellowships begin, like Lydia and her household or the jailer in Acts 16. One disciple at a time, one person of peace at a time, one household at a time, until the day our Lord returns. - *Shepherd Lambur
